What are the liturgical seasons and why do we celebrate them?

In the "Directory for Worship" in the PC(USA) Book of Order it states: "God has provided a rhythm of seasons which orders life and influences the church's worship. God's work of redemption in Jesus Christ offers the Church a central pattern for ordering worship in relationship to significant occasions in the life of Jesus and of the people of God. The Church has thus come to observe the following days and seasons:

- 1. Advent, a season to recollect the hope of the coming of Christ, and to look forward to the Lord's coming again;
- 2. Christmas, a celebration of the birth of Christ;
- 3. Epiphany, a day for commemorating God's self-manifestation to all people;
- **4. Lent**, a season of spiritual discipline and preparation, beginning with **Ash Wednesday**, anticipating the celebration of the death and resurrection of Christ;
- 5. Holy Week, a time of remembrance and proclamation of the atoning suffering and death of Jesus Christ (which included Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday);
- **6. Easter**, the day of the Lord's resurrection and the season of rejoicing that commemorates his ministry until his Ascension, and continues through
- 7. the **Day of Pentecost**, the celebration of the gift of the Holy Spirit to the Church.

The church also observes other liturgical days such as **Baptism of the Lord**, **Transfiguration of the Lord**, **Trinity Sunday**, **All Saints Day and Christ the King Sunday**." (W-3.2002)

By embracing the unique and rich rhythm of the church year as expressed through these liturgical seasons, we as worshippers are able to experience the full depth of Christian worship and truly appreciate God's movement in our lives during the different seasons of the church calendar.

This month the Session gathered for its stated meeting on February 20th. The following items were discussed or acted upon:

• The Session received a letter of appreciation from the Presbytery's Generosity Team, thanking our Church for its faithful support of the mission and work of our Presbytery in the past and its pledge of continuing support for 2024.

The Session approved a number of

- initiatives proposed by our very active Local Mission Committee, to be conducted at various times during 2024. They include two outreach opportunities during the next few months: (i) support of the Way Free Medical Clinic with donations of diapers, wipes and other baby items in February and March, and (ii) support of the Clay County Safe Animal Shelter with donations of dog and cat supplies in May. Other ministry outreach opportunities approved by the Session, which are planned for later in the year, include a school supply drive for local schools in August, collections for Thanksgiving Baskets for the Green Cove Springs Food Pantry, and continued support of the
- The Session heard a report from Bob Higel, our elder commissioner to the Winter Stated Meeting of Presbytery on the actions taken at the meeting, which included adopting a Presbytery budget for 2024, and adoption of a revised Presbytery Sexual Misconduct Policy.

 The Session also heard reports from our Session committees on their work and plans for the coming year.



Boy Scouts Certificate of Appreciation By Green Cove Springs City Council


